





Call for Papers: PopFest 2019

PopFest is an annual Population Studies conference organised by PhD students for PhD students, with the aim to bring together researchers from different Social Science disciplines such as Demography, Human Geography, Social Statistics, Public Health, Social Policy, International Development, Sociology, Economics, Anthropology, Gender Studies, Urban Planning, Politics and other fields related to Population Studies.

Submission:

Abstracts for both oral presentations and posters are welcomed. Theoretical as well as empirical papers include, but are not limited to, the following topics: Families, Fertility, Sexual and Reproductive Health, Internal and International Migration, Mobility, Ageing, Life course, Inequality, Health, Historical Demography, Mortality, and Methodological Approaches.

Submissions should include a title and an abstract of no more than 300 words. We advise applicants to use the following structure:

- 1. BACKGROUND. What is the motivation for this submission?
- 2. OBJECTIVE. What specific question(s) does this submission address?
- 3. METHODS. What data? What methods?
- 4. RESULTS. What are the main findings?
- 5. CONCLUSIONS. What do the findings mean?

Submissions will open the 11th Febuary and close the 15th March, 2019. Applicants will be notified of acceptance by 25th March.

PopFest also gives postgraduates the opportunity to chair sessions. If you are interested in chairing a session, please indicate this in your submission. There are also a limited number of student bursaries available. If the applicant is interested in applying for a bursary they must add 150 words to their application form outlining their reasons.
